

Residents Required to Obey Parking Regulations

The Irving Police Department reminds motorists of city and state parking regulations. Violations can result in fines or the towing of vehicles. Following are common violations.

It is illegal to park vehicles:

- On a sidewalk.
- In front of a driveway.
- On the grass in front or side yards.
- On a street, alley or public way for more than 48 hours.
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant, 20 feet of a crosswalk, or 30 feet of a stop sign or traffic signal.
- In an accessible parking space without displaying the appropriate plate or placard, even if a driver or passenger of the vehicle has a disability.
- In an accessible space when neither the driver nor any passenger has a disability, even if the vehicle displays the appropriate plate or placard.

City ordinance requires that drivers parallel park their vehicles within 18 inches of the edge of a roadway, facing in the direction of legal traffic flow. It is illegal to park a trailer, recreational vehicle or boat on the street. For more information, call the Irving Police Department at (972) 721-2518.
